

# TRANSFER OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIP

New transfer students will be selected each year to receive a \$4000 per year scholarship for up to three years. Applicants must be transfer students from other colleges who will be sophomores or juniors upon enrollment at Gonzaga (minimum of 46 quarter or 31 semester credits earned at the time of application) and intend to pursue a Bachelor degree full-time.

### **APPLICATION GUIDELINES:**

- Apply for admission to Gonzaga University by March 1 for fall or November 15 for spring. <u>https://www.commonapp.org/Login</u>
- Complete all requirements on the reverse side of this form, including essay, by April 1 for fall or November 15 for spring
- Optional: submit a Federal Application for Student Aid (FAFSA) for the upcoming academic year and list Gonzaga as one of your choices (#003778). FAFSA applications are available from the Financial Aid Office on on-line at <u>https://fafsa.ed.gov/</u>

### TO CONTINUE TO QUALIFY FOR THIS SCHOLARSHIP, STUDENTS WILL:

- Enroll over consecutive years (without transferring to another institution)
- Complete 12 or more credits each term
- Maintain "good academic standing," as defined in the current University Catalogue
